## **Piedmont Council Services**

- **Camps and Activities:** Organizes annual Scout programs, including: Cub Scout Day Camp, Pinewood Derby, Highlander Hikes, Air Day, Tiger Cub Twilight Camp, Webelos Webeloree, Scouting for Food, Bike Fest, Boy Scout Camporee, Career Day and more.
- **Summer Programs**: Organizes and coordinates participation in Boy Scouts of America National Jamboree, World Jamboree, and at High Adventure Bases (Philmont Scout Ranch, Northern Tier, and Florida Seabase), as well as with other councils for summer camp experiences.
- **Training:** Trains leaders and volunteers in youth protection and leadership skills, including Basic and Advanced Leader Training and Den Chief Training.
- Membership: Organizes and facilitates recruitment.
- **Camper Scholarships:** Provides financial support as needed.

- **Program Information**: Develops monthly email newsletter, PR & updated website.
- **Recognition**: Coordinates recognition and awards for Scouts and volunteers.
